

The Call of Abram

12 Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. ² And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. ³ I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." ⁴ So Abram went, as the LORD had told him, and Lot went with him.

Covenant Relationship With God

Faith + Obedience = Blessing

Faith

Faith is the means by which we gain access to God

Eph. 3:11 -12 This was according to the eternal purpose that he has realized in Christ Jesus our Lord, in whom we have boldness and access with confidence through our faith in him.

The question behind every step of faith: Do I believe that the <u>life</u> God has for me is better than the <u>life</u> I can create for myself?

Obedience

Obedience is the step we take to lay hold of the blessings of God

James 2:21-23 So also faith by itself, if it does not have works, is dead... ²¹ Was not Abraham our father justified by works when he offered up his son Isaac on the altar? ²² You see that faith was active along with his works, and faith was completed by his works; ²³ and the Scripture was fulfilled that says, "Abraham believed God, and it was counted to him as righteousness"—and he was called a friend of God

- Obedience comes before <u>blessing</u>
- Obedience defies <u>worldly</u> Logic
- Obedience often results in temporary <u>suffering</u>

Blessing

God's blessings are already given to us

- We are Blessed to be a <u>Blessing</u>
- God is always faithful to his promise Deut. 7:9
- Blessings = <u>Anything</u> that is an expression of God's <u>love</u> and <u>goodness</u> towards us
