- 3. What insight, principle, or observation from this week's message did you find to be most helpful, eve-opening, or troubling? Explain.

4. What, do you feel, is your biggest sphere of influence? How does God use you as an example in this sphere? What are the challenges of being in this position?

- 5. At the core of Jesus' ministry is discipleship. Jesus found 12 men to invest in, who in turn invested in their own spheres of influence. Read Mark 1:16-28. Jot down any insights, questions, or key observations.
- 6. After you've read Mark 1:16-28, answer these questions:
 - a. What does Jesus commit to when He calls the first disciples? (Vs. 17) How does this promise relate to us today?
 - b. In what way(s) was Jesus an example to the disciples?
 - c. In what ways did Jesus use His words to grow the disciples?

Digging Deeper

- 1. In Philippians 3:17, Paul encourages others to "pattern [their] lives after [his]." Why do you think Paul was so confident in saying this? Is this a statement you would feel comfortable making to people? Why or why not?
- 2. In what areas of your life are you a good example for disciples to follow? Are there any areas of your life that Jesus is leading you to change? How could discipleship help you grow and make those changes?
