
- ➤ Who do you lie most often to: others, God, or yourself? Explain.

## **The Dangers of Dishonesty**

#### We lie to Others: Dishonesty undermines our relationships

**Jeremiah 9:5** Friend deceives friend, and no one speaks the truth. They have taught their tongues to lie;

Matthew 23:16-22

### We Lie to God: Dishonesty is rebellious to the Heart of God

**Acts 5:4** What made you think of doing such a thing? You have not lied just to human beings but to God."

**Numbers 23:19, Exodus 6:7 -** *God is a Commitment Keeper* 

**Proverbs 12:22 –** God Detests Lies

**John 8:44 –** Satan is the Father of Lies

## We lie to **Ourselves**: Dishonesty damages our **Souls**

**Palm 119:29** *Keep me from lying to myself; give me the privilege of knowing your instructions.* 

**1 John 2:4** If someone claims, "I know God," but doesn't obey God's commandments, that person is a liar and is not living in the truth.

**Matthew 5:33-37** <sup>33</sup> "Again you have heard that it was said to those of old, 'You shall not swear falsely, but shall perform to the Lord what you have sworn.' <sup>34</sup> But I say to you, Do not take an oath at all, either by heaven, for it is the throne of God, <sup>35</sup> or by the earth, for it is his footstool, or by Jerusalem, for it is the city of the great King. <sup>36</sup> And do not take an oath by your head, for you cannot make one hair white or black. <sup>37</sup> Let what you say be simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything more than this comes from evil.
